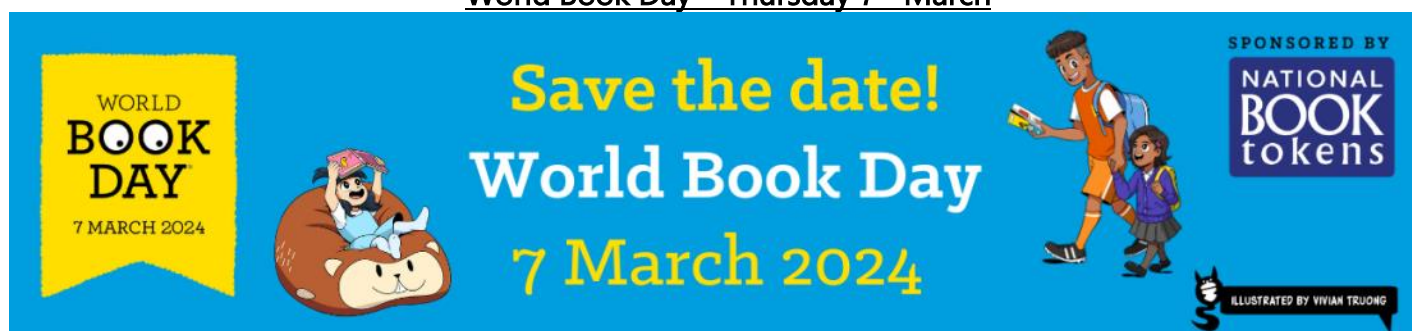
### Punctuality

Please remember that we are a **Nut Free School**. We have children in school with severe nut allergies and therefore any snacks or packed lunch items that contain nuts are a hazard.

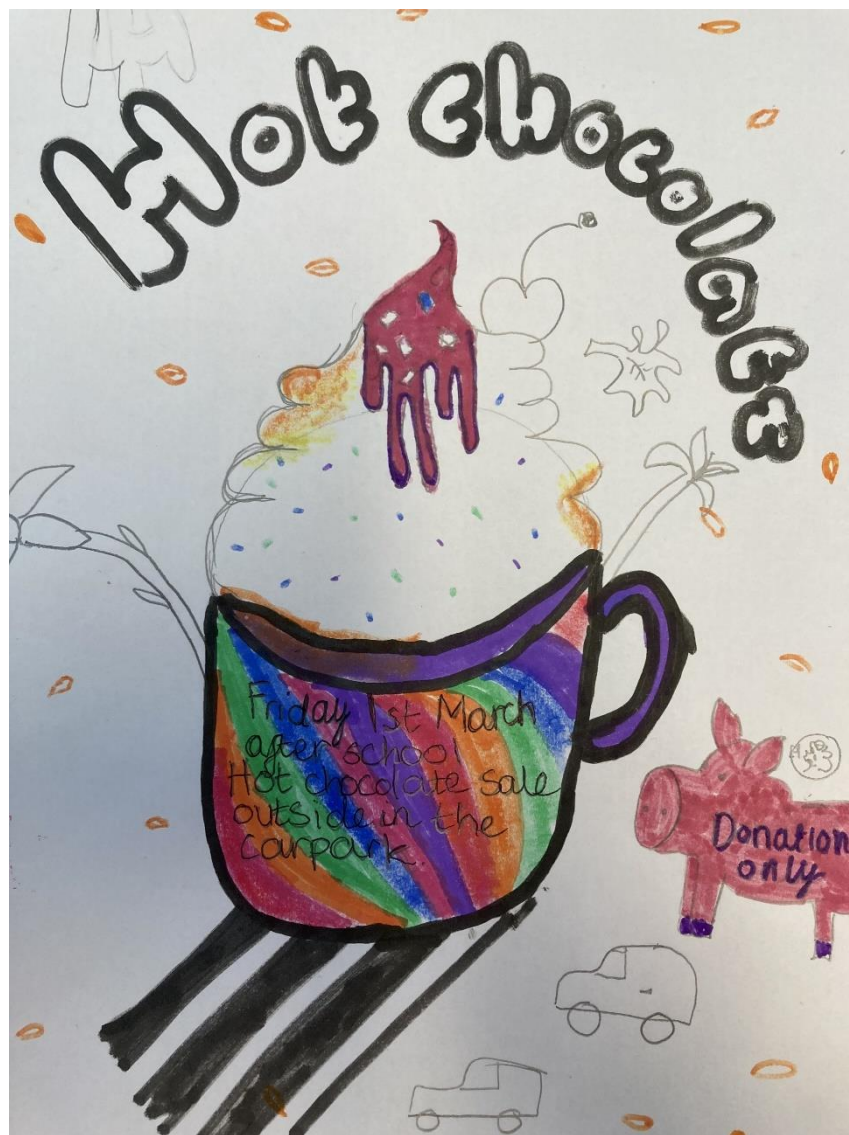
