Sports Day 2017

The forecast is 'good enough' for Thursday with some cloud cover to help keep temperatures and glare down and no serious rain beforehand so that we can hope for 'good to firm' going underfoot. Certainly we will attempt to run Sports Day this week (Thursday 15th June) and only if it does rain overnight with further downpours threatening will we postpone.

For those parents for whom this is their first sports day, the event is held at the school field (off Silverdale Road – Marlborough Avenue turn). The timetable is as follows (although times are approximate):

- 10:15 children's Packet Ship Speed-Agility-Resilience and Teamwork activities.
- 12:00 lunch
- 13:30 Junior Relay
- 13:40 Packet Ship flat running race heats (all y1-y6 children who wish to participate)
- 14:20 Sprint Finals (winners from heats representing each packet in each class)
- 14:30 Reception Class flat running races
- 14:40 Pre-School Fun Race
- 14:50 The Grand Caterpillar Race (all children)
- 15:00 Sports Day Winners' Presentation

You are welcome to join us for as much of the day as you wish and are able. Essentially, the morning provides an opportunity for children to work towards their own PBs (personal bests) in the supportive atmosphere of mixed age groups from their packet ships. This is also a good time for parents who'd like to see their children participating in a range of athletics based activities.

The afternoon session is the more traditional competitive session. Every child is given the opportunity to race in their packet ship heat and the winners go on to the representative race finals. The crowd does usually build up on the embankment for the afternoon and we ask that parents stay on that side of the field until asked to collect their children following the results presentation.
