School Maintenance Update

Over the Easter holidays, **new fire doors** have been fitted to the hall, playground and Reception Class. We have also had a **new computer server** fitted by NCi. In the lower playground, there is a welfare unit for the company fitting our **new boiler**, which could take a month to install. While they are working in the lower carpark, we have reopened the upper carpark but this is only a temporary measure. The emergency fencing will remain in the lower playground until **new windows** are fitted along the top corridor, which should be installed this term. We also have a massive project starting soon, refurbishing the current resources room and making it into a **new therapy room** suitable for individual and group sessions. Marvellous Mariners' have helped create a **new beautiful woven willow fence**, creating privacy for the Reception class when they are learning outside.
