Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term! We had a wonderful INSET day, mapping out the weeks ahead and developing our teaching and learning strategies. Teachers will be sending home *Curriculum Information* next week so you can find out more about what is happening in school and talk about your child's learning with them. This term is full to the brim with summer loveliness: sports days, residential to BF Adventure and London, Coronation celebrations, school trips, a whole school summer production all alongside a full creative curriculum. Please see **Dates for the Diary** for the term ahead. Hopefully your Easter break provided the children with some rest and relaxation... they are going to need a whole lot of energy!

### Proposed Industrial Action – Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May.

Unfortunately, the industrial strike action last term did not have the required effect on funding for schools and therefore two more dates have been agreed for strike action. Marlborough School will be closed to all pupils on those days. This is not a decision we make lightly but we have no choice in making the government know that the proposed budget does not allow us to give our children appropriate provision. We pride ourselves on being able to ensure that **A Rising Tide Lifts All Ships**, which means that, on top of quality teaching, we have additional support for those who find areas of learning challenging. We provide regular reading, writing and maths support, well-being and emotional support, Speech and Language Therapy, sensory and physio support, small group work and individual support. The majority of children, at some point in their school journey, will need additional support with an aspect of their development. The proposed funding offer will mean that **A Rising Tide Leaves Behind Those Who Cannot Keep Up**, which is something we cannot stand by and let happen. Thank you for your support through these difficult negotiations.

Please note that Class 4's residential visit will not be affected by strike action.

Plymouth Argyle will be offering child care provision at Marlborough School for the two days for £20 each day. A letter and booking link will be sent out soon.

### Learning Out and About and in School
