## An Lester Trumach - The Packet Ship

Dear Parents and Carers,

It is hard to believe, but it is nearly a year since our last Ofsted inspection. Following the successful inspection, we have been busy developing our provision and for the past year we have been working through our three-year School Development Plan. We have three priorities on the plan, two of which are based on Ofsted's recommended improvement areas.

School Development Plan 2022- 2025 - Targeted Priorities	
1	To accelerate the attainment of pupils in mathematics in all year groups.
2	To develop the rigour of the wider curriculum through clear sequencing and assessment. (Ofsted action point - Feb 22)
3	To develop the leadership role of subject leaders. (Ofsted action point - Feb 22)

**Priority 1** - Our teaching team are ensuring that the provision of maths is the best it can be. Last year, our maths results were well above the national average, but we want all our children to have the same passion for maths as they have for reading.

**Priority 2** - The sequencing and assessment of our curriculum is being developed to ensure children have identified the links between subjects. For example, the children learn how to manipulate clay in Reception, creating pinch pots. In Class 1 this skill develops so they can make a tea cup, in Class 2 they add new tools and connecting techniques to create tin mines, Class 4 make Clarice Cliff coil pots and finally they are able to sculpt and create a dragon's eye sculpture due to the development of their skills.

**Priority 3** - Subject leaders are working with the Local Authority cluster groups to ensure we have the best curriculum offer for our children.

The year has zoomed by, but the amount of effort put in by the Marlborough team is amazing; we are always striving to develop our practice, curriculum and provision.


